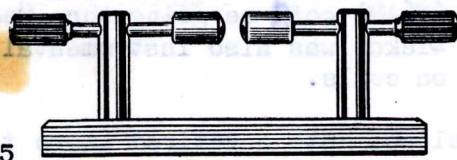

Jan., 1915 - started Wireless exp. with broomhandles and galenas.
1919. 6NW - ½ kw. rotary & loosecoupler; audion rec'r.
Sept. 1924 - Opened Nadeau Radio-Elec. shop - later Manchester Radio
1928 - " another branch - Oakland, Calif. (closed LA branch)
Jan., 1932 - Started Modern Radio Labs. (MRL) mail/order biz - and
closed stores. Got into m/o biz by accident. Ran xval set
ad in old SWCraft mag. for 25¢. Floor covered with letters
with 25¢ in them. After the plans they wanted parts. So,
awaywe went!

At about same time - figured on winding coils on tube
bases - with celluloid form fitted to them. Don Wallace
(W6AM) got me going thru Radio dealer/distributors.
Dickow was also instrumental in helping us get started
on coils.

Finally developed into a retired (more tired than re-tired!) biz out
of our home. We print (By 1250 multilith) a 50 page 8½x11 cat and
14 page flyer. Also \$16 worth of our own Radio Handbooks, plans, etc.

The next question: Howinell am I going to get out of the biz?
